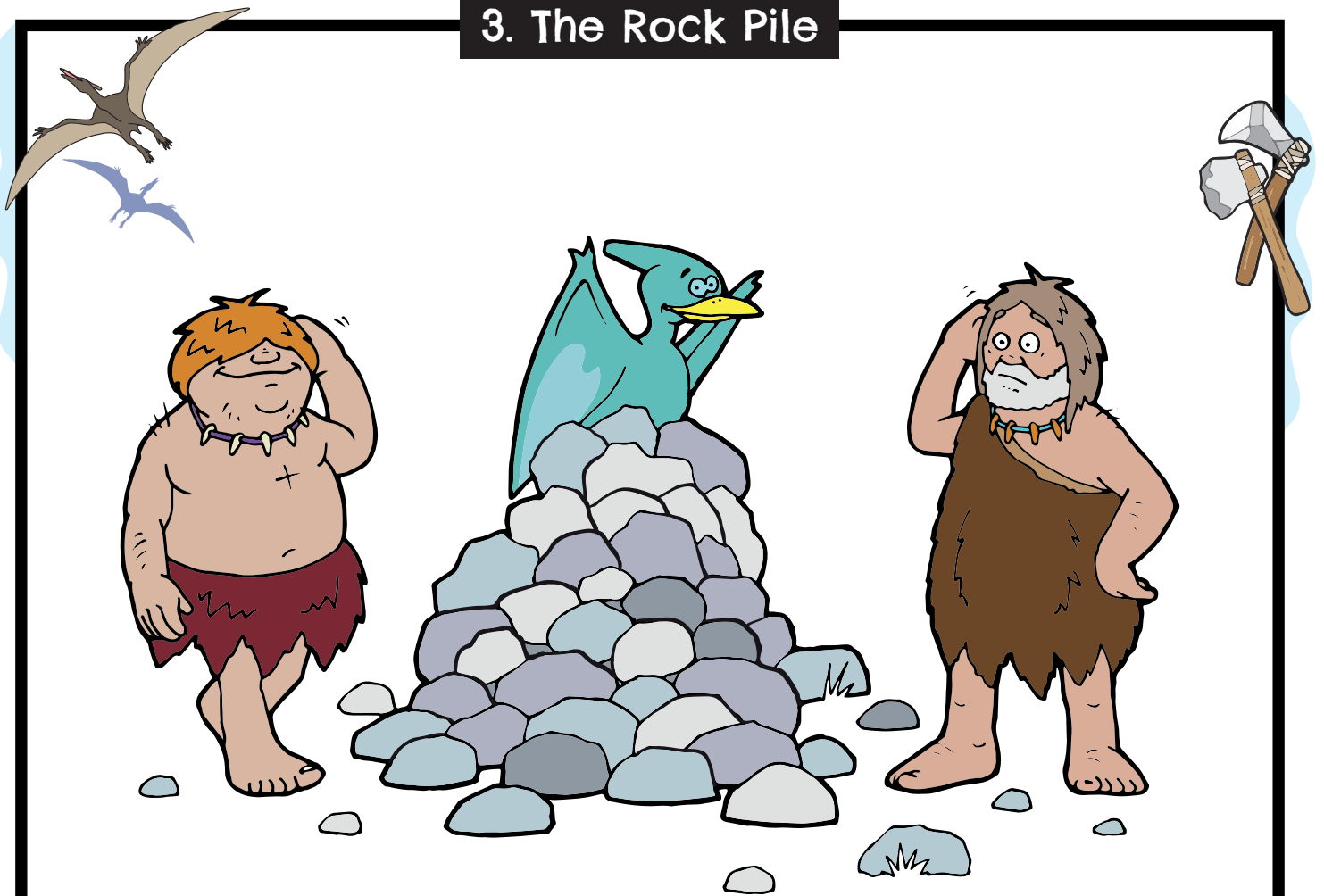


3. The Rock Pile

The only trouble was the great pile of rocks in the garden.

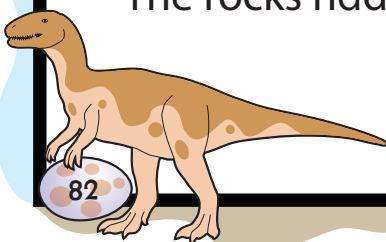
Sol had carelessly dumped all the rocks from the cave outside the door.
