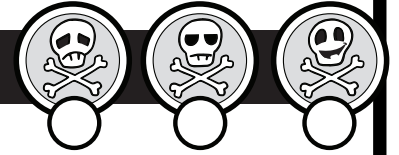


# The Captain's Cabin

Captain Starling's cabin was rather small and cramped. It was also very dusty, but she didn't have time to clean it now. There were more important things to do!



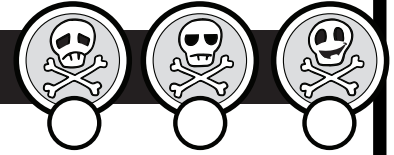

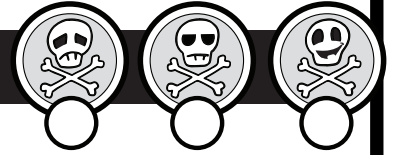
