



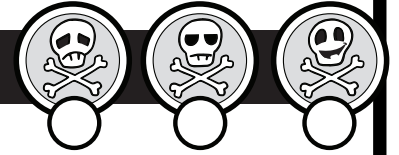
The Island

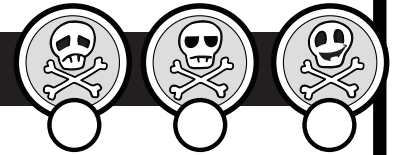

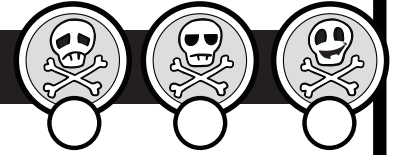

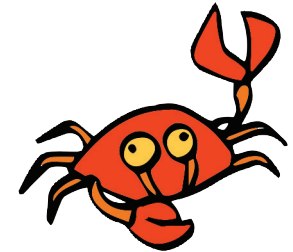
