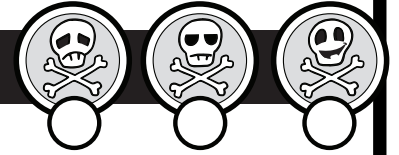


The Search Begins ³

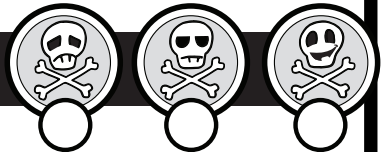

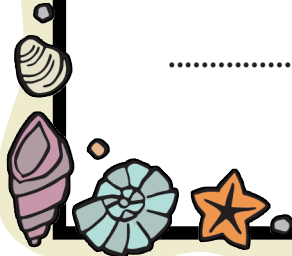

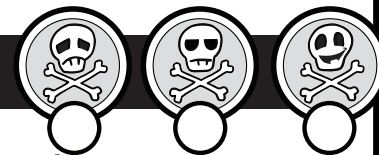
