

"They may have taken the key, but we still have most of the map," said Stragglebeard helpfully.

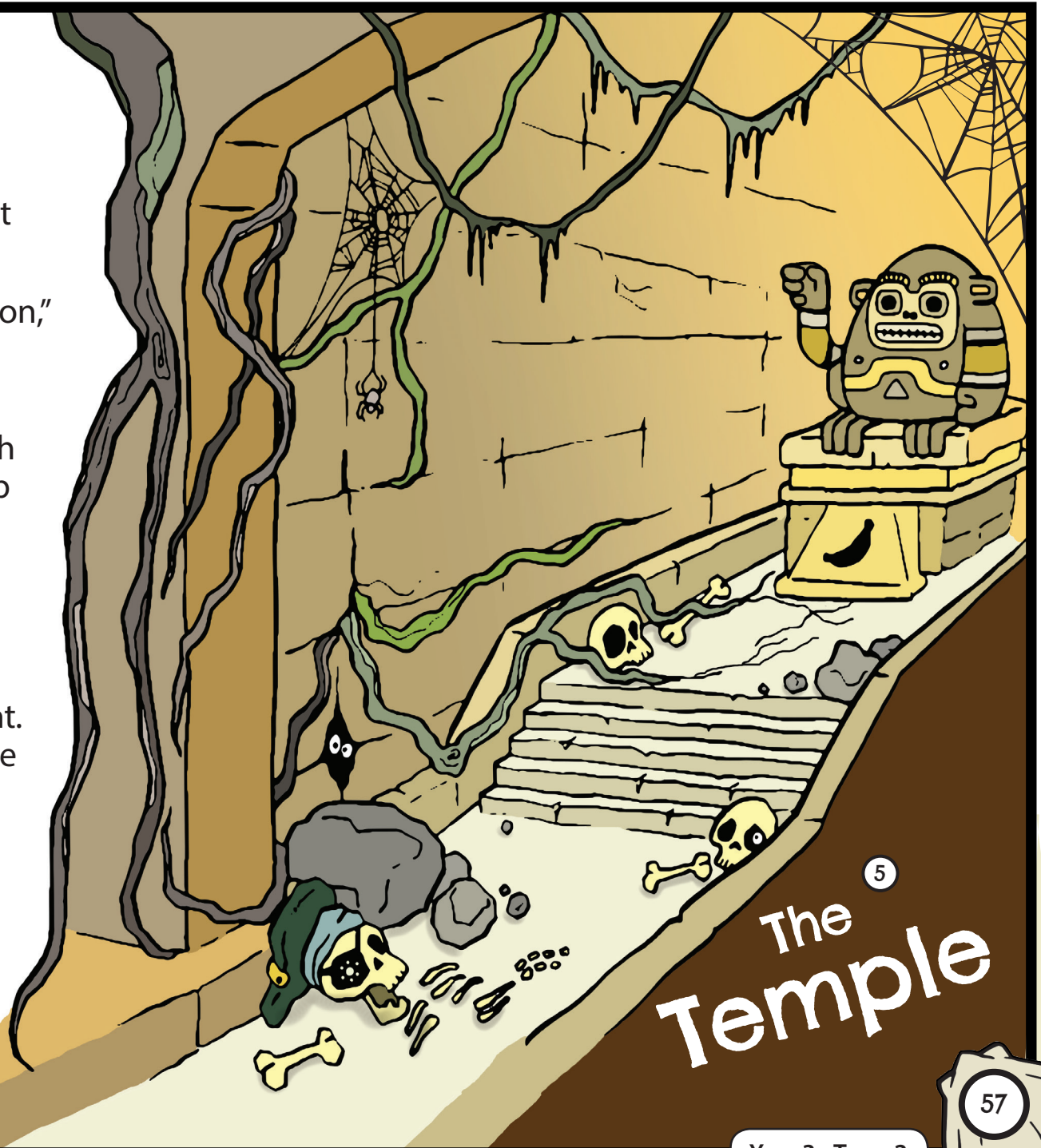
"And we can easily break into the chest without the key," added Barnaby.

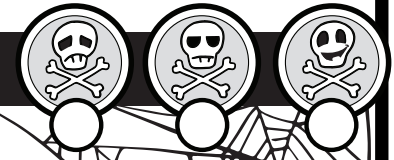

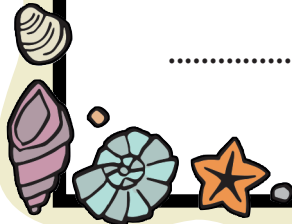

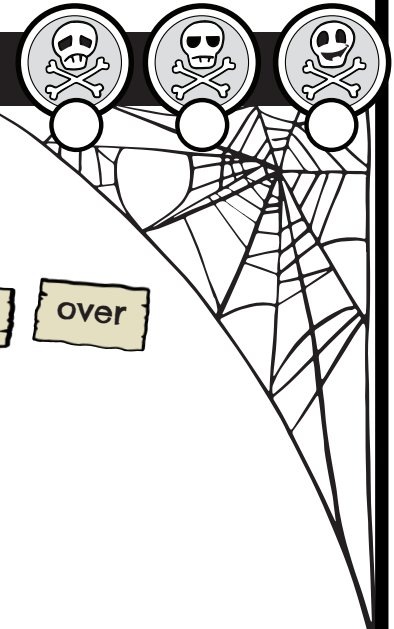
