A third monkey appeared wearing yet another hat.

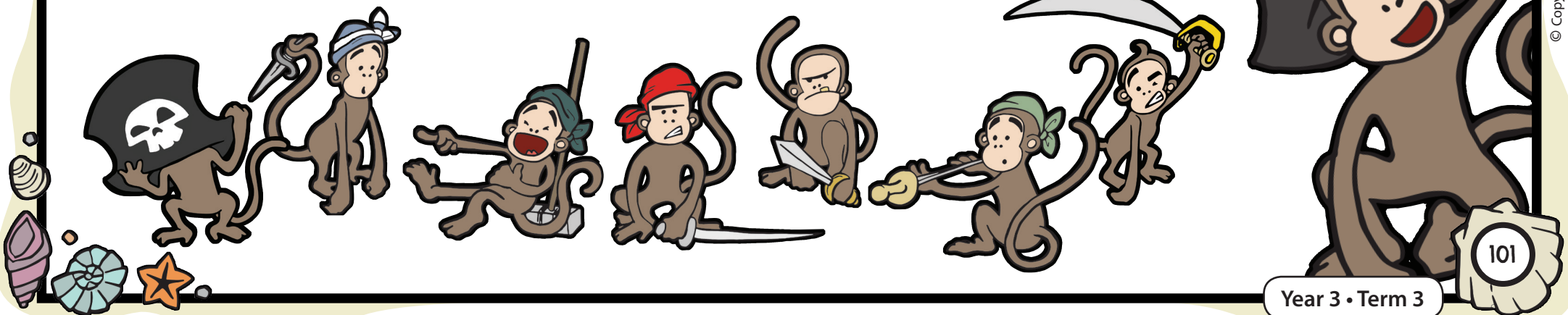
"Is that Blackheart's hat?" she asked.

"Yes, it's his alright!" agreed Bo'sun Barnaby.

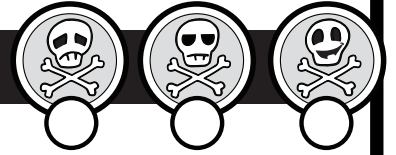
"And those cutlasses belong to the Black Pirates! They are definitely theirs!"
