- Safety was a fundamental reason to move to St George's and I have been incredibly impressed by the staff.
- You've all dealt with friendship/bullying issues in a responsive way and we are confident with your approach to this and the support offered.
- Unsure about the ethos of 'healthy school' and the meals offered
- The provision and investment in a PE specialist is really welcome and makes up for the lack in green space.
- Varied and inclusive PE curriculum and after school provision.
- It is concerning that my child states that he doesn't feel he can speak openly to staff about any issues. My child does report poor behaviour frequently.
- Thank you for all you do-you're all a credit to your profession.
- I feel my child is in a very safe place and is taken very good care of while she learns.
- My child talks or mentions bullying quite often so it's probably a sign he is made aware of what bullying is. I

trust that the school is committed to awareness, prevention and reporting (if it happens) of bullying inside and outside of school.

- Cannot fault the response when any concerns have been raised. Always dealt with sensitively and swiftly. I feel the school always handles this exceptionally well.
- There has been repeated bullying incidents with the same child, which has always been addressed each time. However, I do feel uneasy at times and am always asking my child if they have been ok today or any incidents.
- When my child experienced a minor friendship issue, we casually raised this with her teacher with a view it would be merely monitored. However, it was taken incredibly seriously and was resolved exceptionally well with my child's wellbeing at the forefront of the decisions whilst both children overcame their blip. Very reassuring and incredibly empathetic.
- I would love a more detailed review of my child's day to day behavior whilst appreciate the magnitude of the task, areas of struggle, particularly emotionally are helpful when fed back.
- I am very happy with everything that the school have done. Excellent school. Thank you.
- Great school with amazing staff. Couldn't have sent my child to a better school.
- I have been really impressed with the school. All three of my children attend and they are all extremely happy, achieving beyond my expectations and I never have to worry about their safety at all. Thank you.
