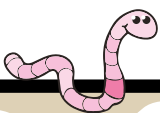
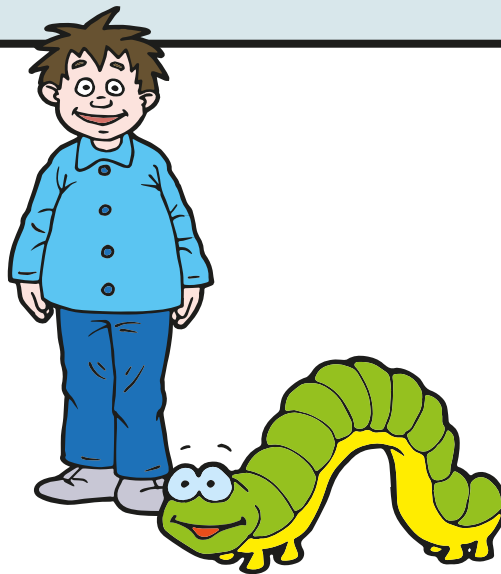

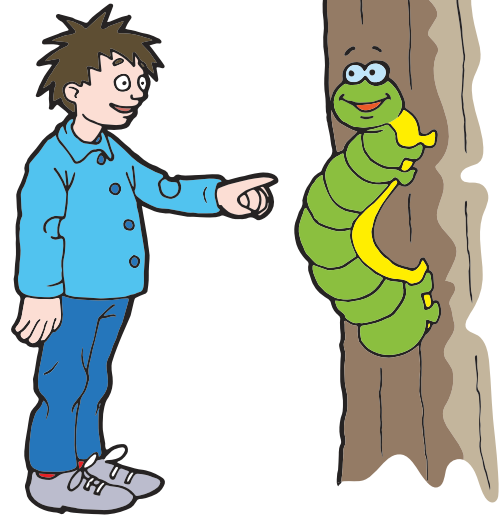

"Hello," says the caterpillar.

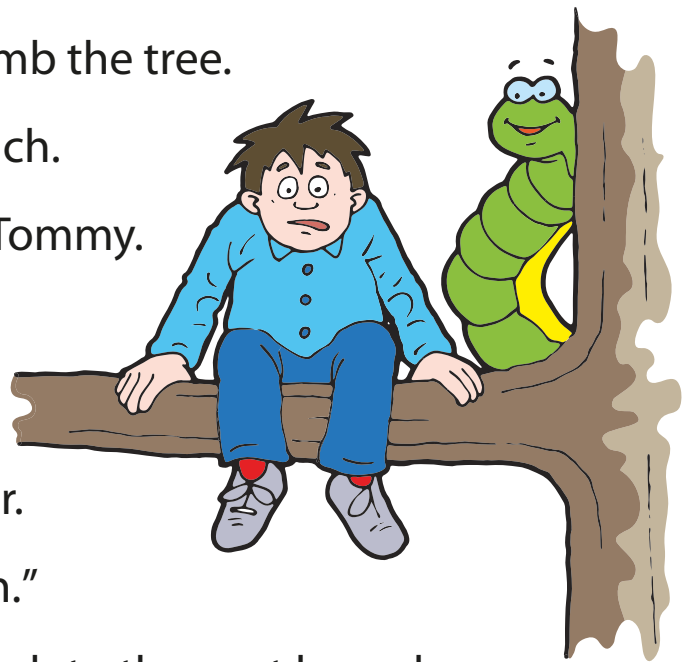
"Hello," says Tommy.

They climb up to the first branch.

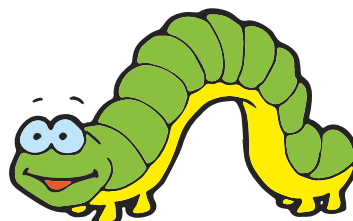
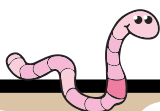
"This is too high for me," says Tommy.

Tommy and the caterpillar climb to the next branch.

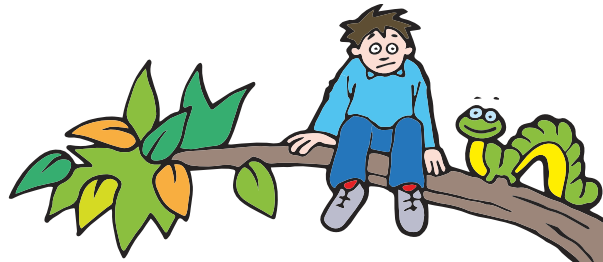




Tommy looks down.

It is a long way down.

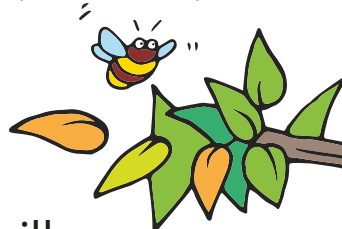
"This is too high for me," says Tommy.

Tommy and the caterpillar are at the very top.

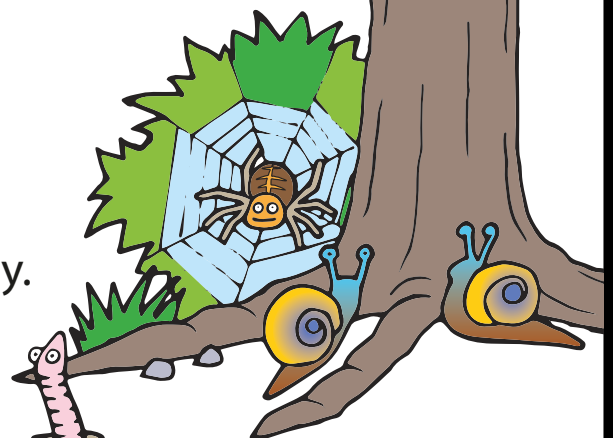
They are very high up.

"Let's climb down."

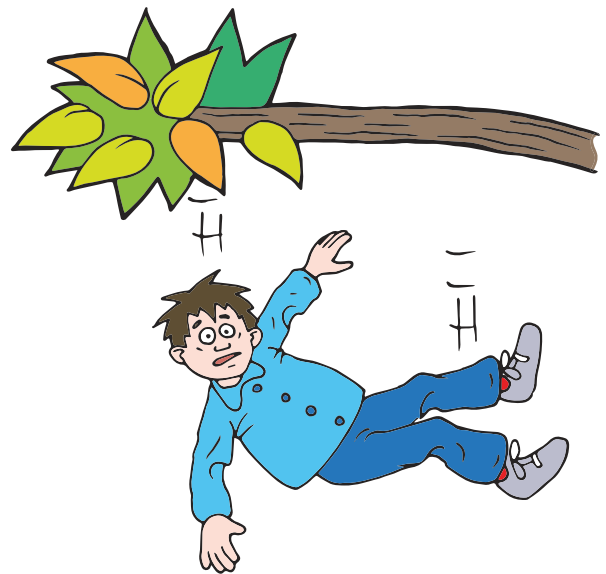
They start to climb down.
