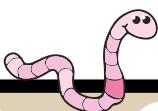
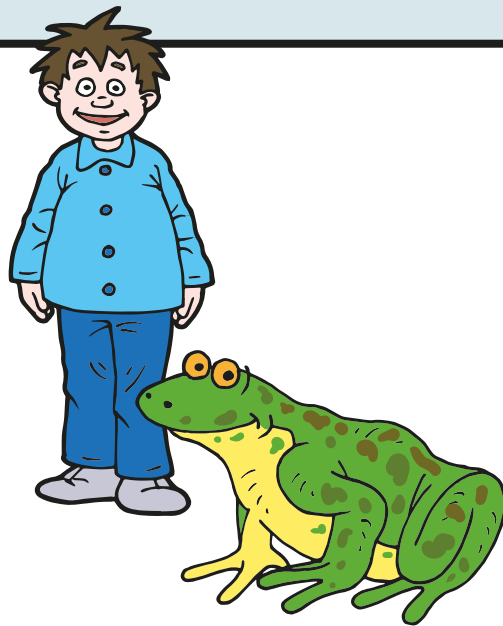




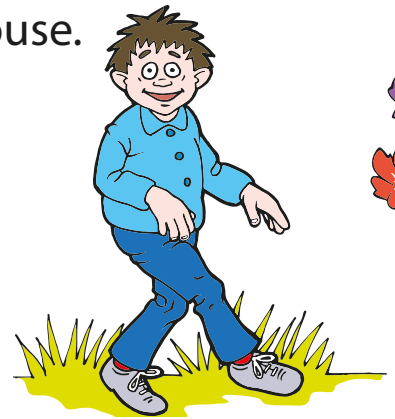

Tommy and the Frog



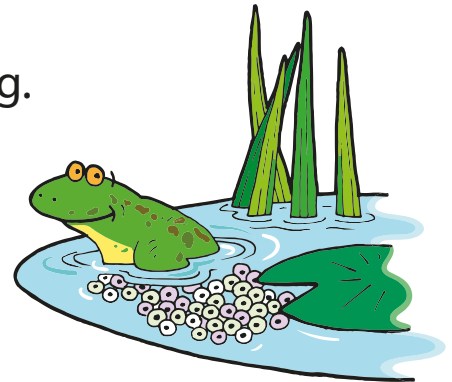
5. Tommy and the Frog

What a naughty little boy!

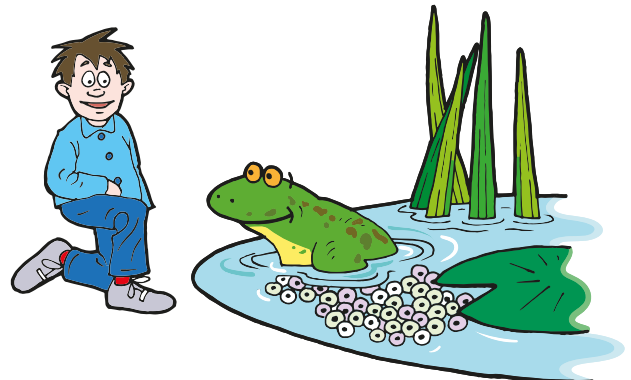


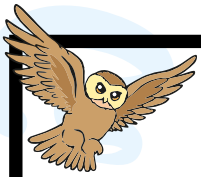
Mum and dad don't allow Tommy in the garden.

Yuk! They feel sticky.

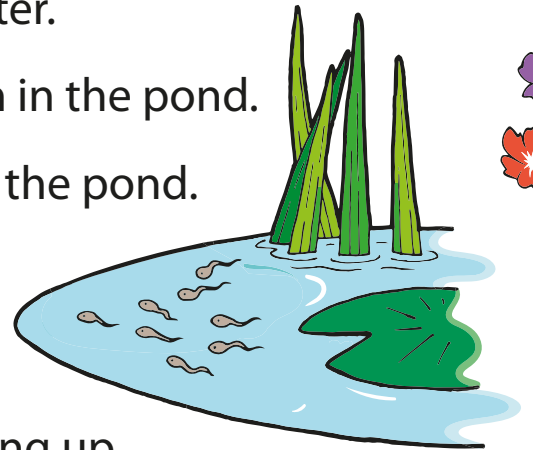




Tommy goes to the pond a few days later.

“Wow! I didn’t know that!” says Tommy.

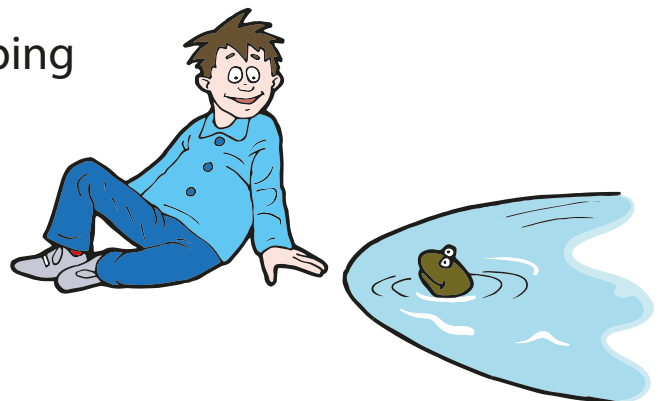
“Will you come and see me again?” asks the tadpole.

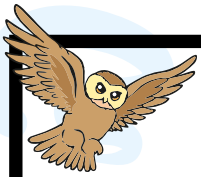


Tommy goes to the pond a few weeks later.

“Hi,” says a little creature popping its head out of the water.

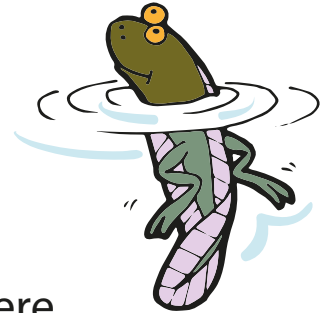




"It's me! The tadpole!" says the tadpole. "I grew two legs."

"You have two legs!" says Tommy. "That's amazing!"

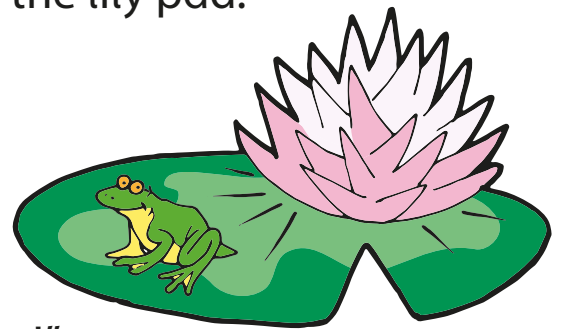
"Will you come and see me again?" asks the tadpole.

"Is that really you?" asks Tommy.

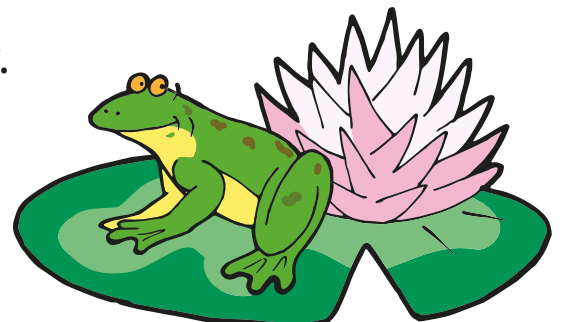
"Yes," says the froglet. "I grew four legs!"

Tommy goes to the pond a few months later.

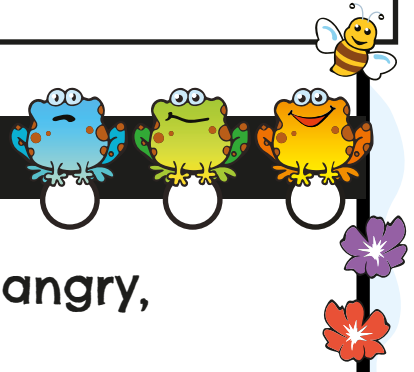
His friend is now a big frog.
