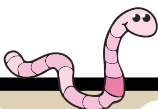
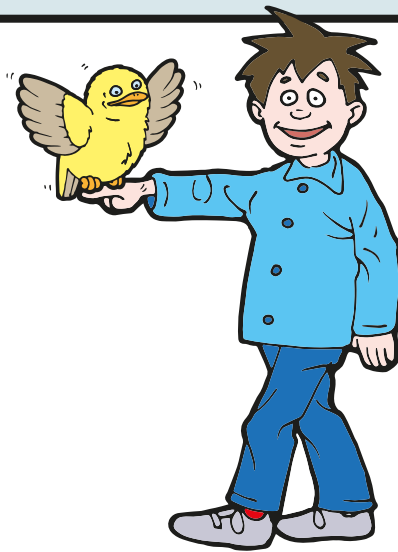


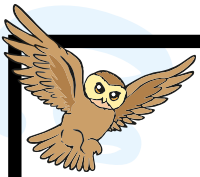

On Monday Tommy goes into the garden.

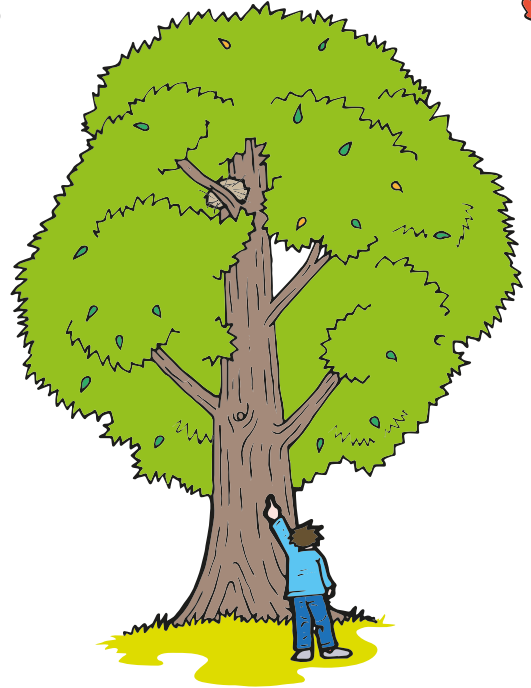
Tommy hears a noise coming from up high in the tree.

What does he see?

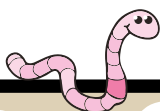
Up high in the tree, he can see a bird's nest.

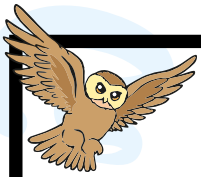
He sees a little head poking over the top of the nest.

"Hello! My name's Tommy," shouts Tommy.

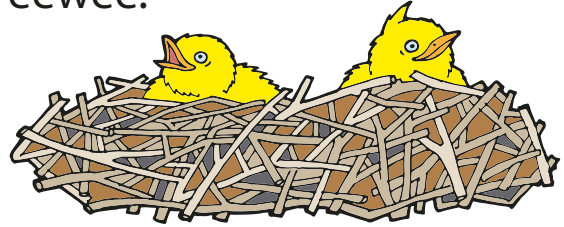
A baby bird looks down at Tommy.

"Hello! My name's Peewee," tweets the baby bird.

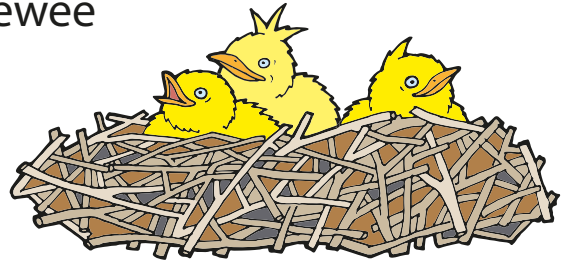




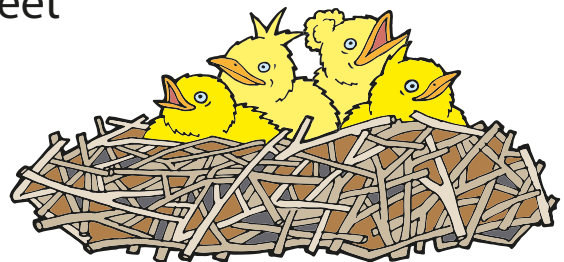
On Tuesday Tommy looks up into the tree.

“This is my brother Yipyap,” tweets Peewee.



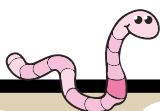
On Wednesday Tommy looks up into the tree.

and Yipyap.

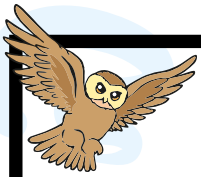


On Thursday Tommy looks up into the tree.

“Yuk!” says Tommy. “Do you eat worms?”

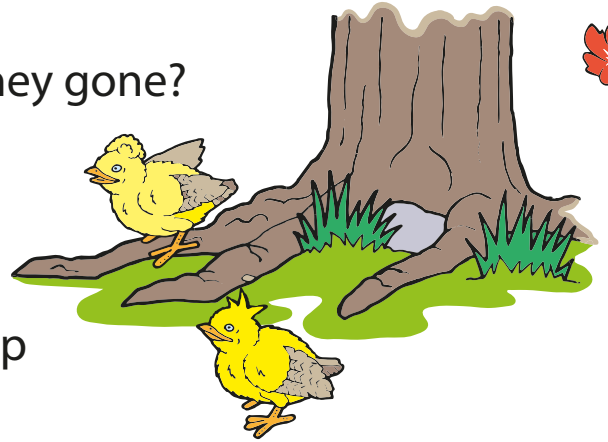




On Saturday Tommy looks up into the tree.

He can't see his friends.

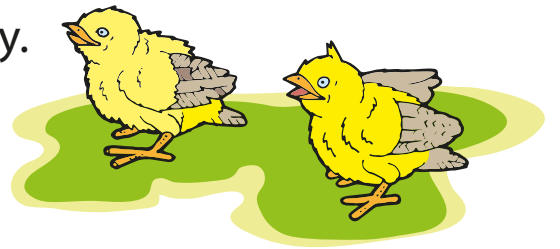
Where can they be? Where have they gone?

Then Rambo the cat comes round the tree.

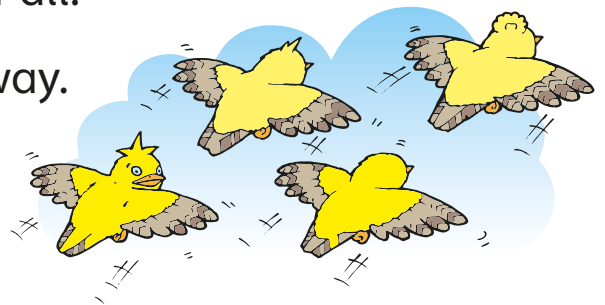


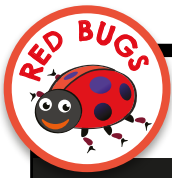
"I'm going to eat you, little birds," says Rambo the cat.

The birds find that they can fly after all.

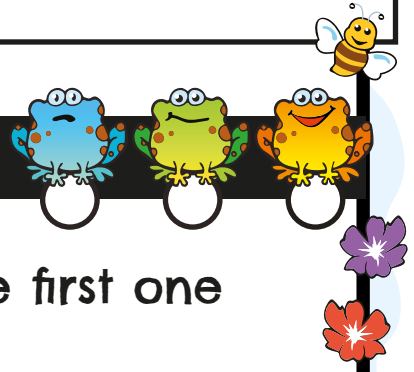
One, two, three, four. They all fly away.

"Now you can fly," says Tommy.



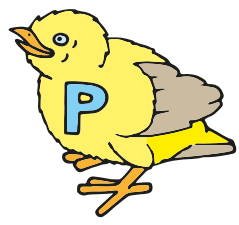
