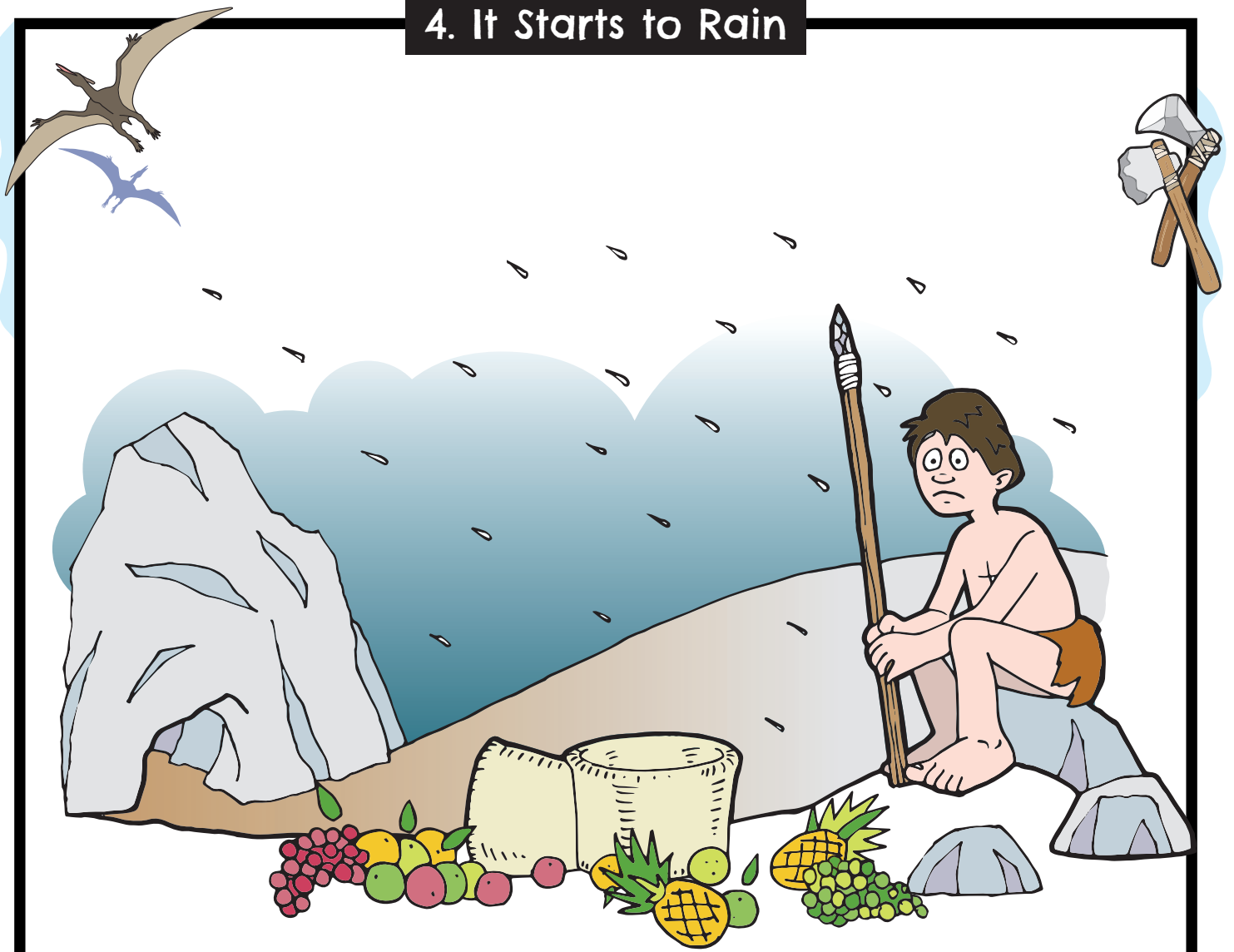


4. It Starts to Rain

What should he eat? Some of the fruit looked unripe.

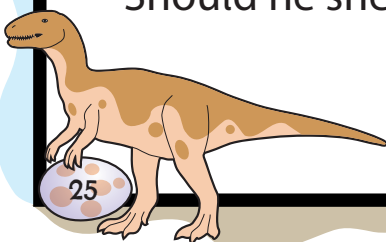
Axel knew that some berries could make you feel unwell.
