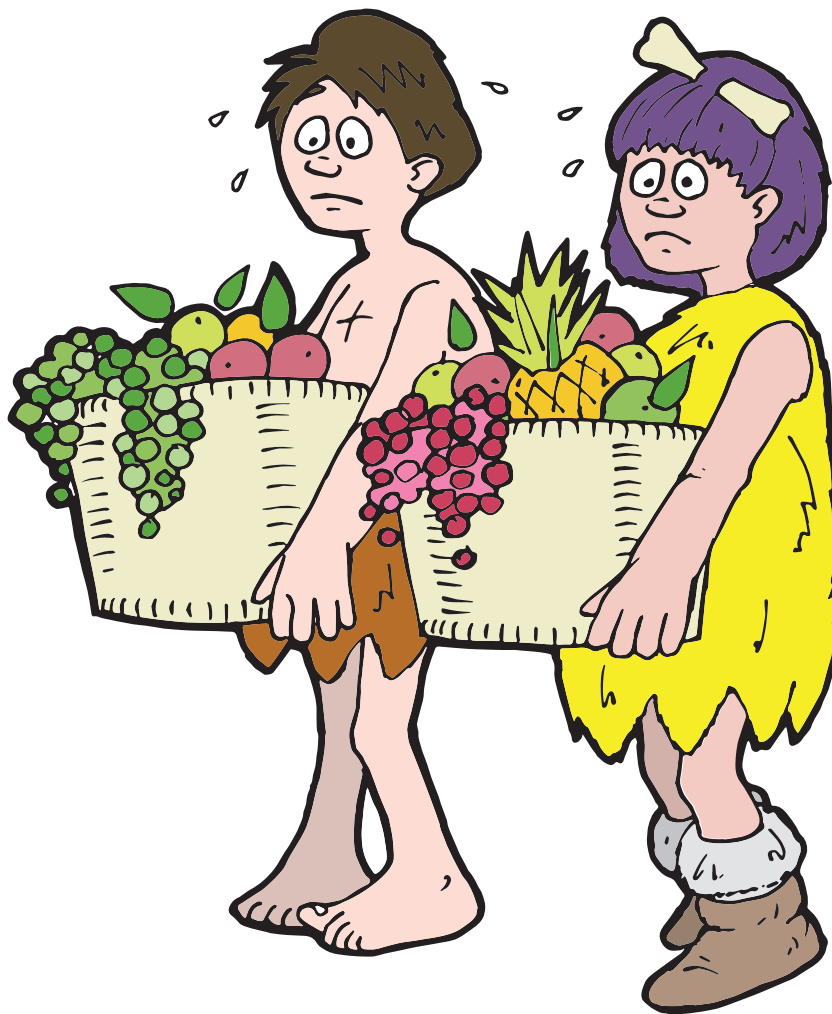


3. Heavy Baskets

"I've got an idea," said Dusk.



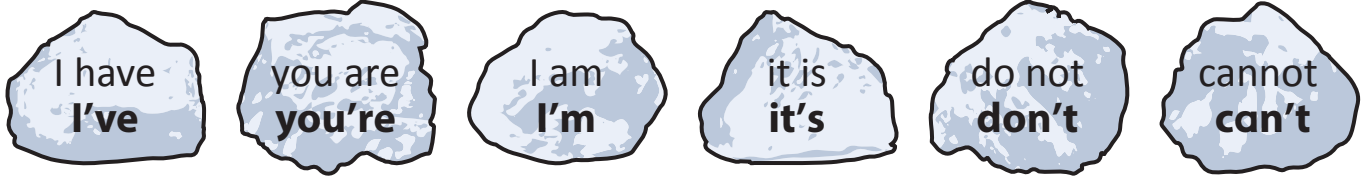
