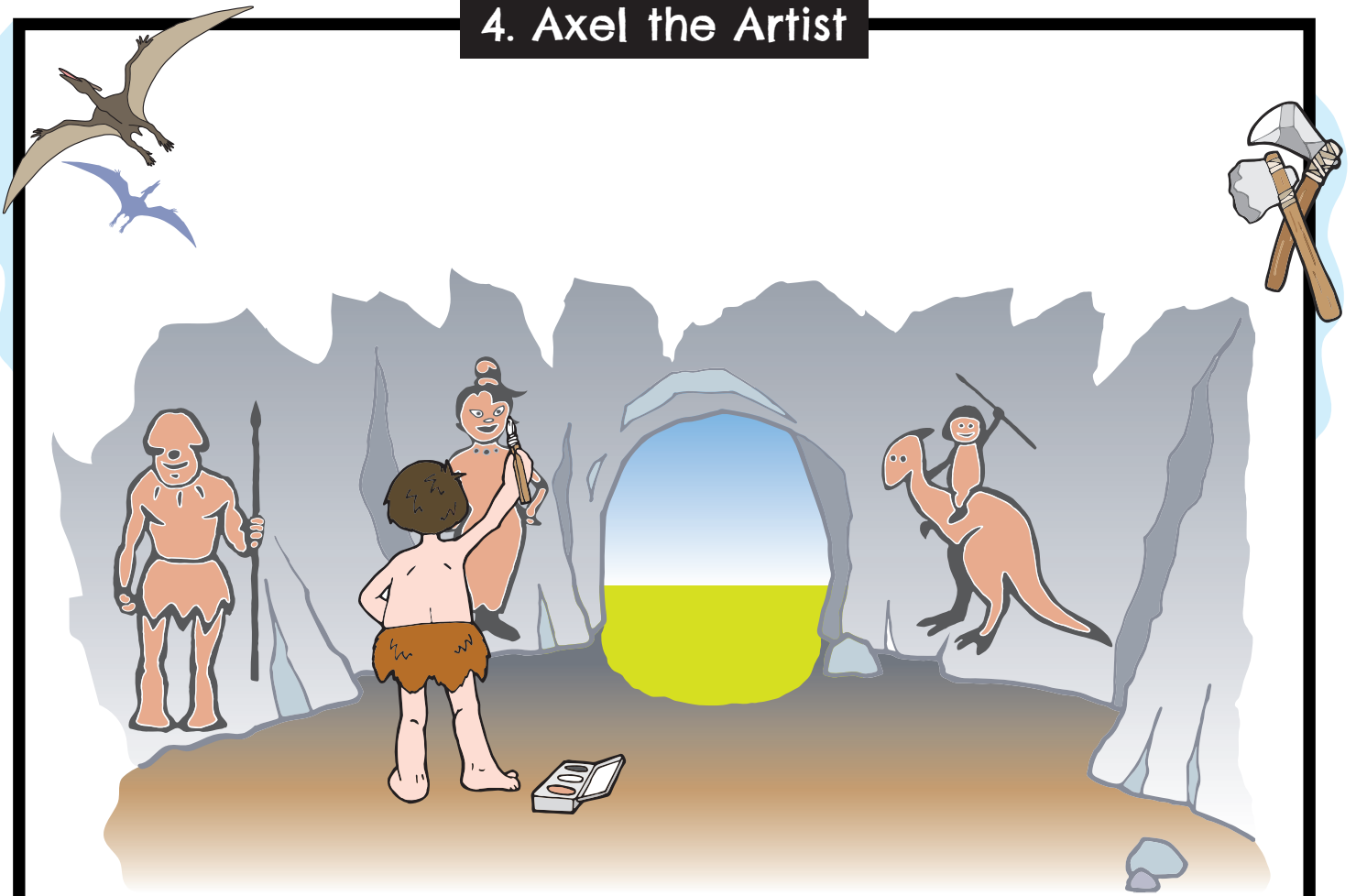


4. Axel the Artist

Luna wanted a beautiful picture of herself on the walls.

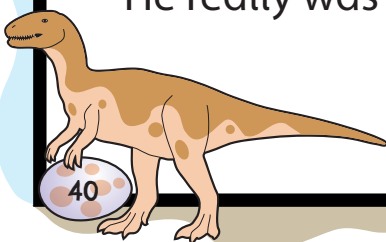
Axel drew a pretty lady wearing a fur dress.
